CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- Every student is expected to maintain strict discipline, peace and good conduct on and off the campus.
- Students are wanted to desist from any act which is likely to damage the name of the college.
- Students either directly or indirectly are prohibited from disturbing the normal working of the college.
- Admissions taken on submission of false and fabricated certificate or misuse of government policies shall be considered ad cognizable offence and be liable to punishment as per the Law.
- Teasing, insulting, Mocking either by act or speech or gesture is an offence punishable with cancellation of admission from the college.
- Students are restrained from any attempt as destroying, misusing and defacing the property of the college. The students are prohibited from erring and lethal weapons including sticks, churis, explosives etc.
- Prior permission of the principal is necessary to be obtained before reporting any matter concerning the college to the press, students shall forfeit their admissions right if they are found guilty of associating, themselves with anti-social activities like provocative speeches, strike, gherao, arson, loot on and off the campus, students should not be associated with any organization outside the college.
- Students are advised to intimate the concerned teacher of their absence from their theory and practical classes, failing which they will be debarred from attending the college.
- So student with less than 75% attendance shall be allowed to take the University exam.
- Every student must carry his/her identity card on the campus to be produced on demand. Non observance of the above rule and any misbehaviour, misconduct or act

of discipline will be severely dealt with and the Principal's decision shall be final and irrevocable.

- The Students shall attend 75% period regularly, failing which will be liable to pay fine
- The Will be imposed.
- *Students must be dressed in the college uniform on prescribe days.*
